Social Studies World Map Project

Parents: The students have been assigned a world map project for Social Studies. The criterion is as followed:

The students need to draw the world map. On their maps they need to label all of the following, lines of longitude, lines of latitude, equator, prime meridian, all seven continents, north and south pole, all hemispheres, and a compass rose.

Students (with help from parents) need to research all seven continents and find TWO interesting facts for each continent to add to their poster.

Please use a small poster board for this, and the students can get as creative as they wish. Please ONLY offer guidance and suggestions to the students. Please DO NOT complete the project for them.

Below is a check list for you students to use to ensure they include everything they need to on their poster.
